

WHO MAY VOTE?

A person is entitled to vote if he or she,

- resides in the local municipality or is the owner or tenant of land there, or the spouse of such owner or tenant;
- is a Canadian citizen;
- is at least 18 years old; and
- is not prohibited from voting by law.

You are entitled to vote once only.

ARE YOU ON THE VOTERS' LIST?

A list of all eligible voters has been prepared and is available at the Town Hall at 2 Mille Roches Rd, Long Sault, ON K0C 1P0.

If you are not on the Voters' List you will not receive a Voter Letter. Visit or call the South Stormont Town Hall to ensure you are on the list and that your personal information is correct. Please note that you require proof of identification (photo) or proof of qualification to vote.

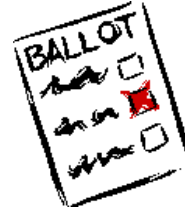

FIRST— RECEIVE YOUR VOTER LETTER

Each eligible voter on the Voters' List will personally receive, by first class mail, a "Voter Instruction Letter" containing the following information:

1. The toll free telephone number to call if you wish to vote by telephone;
2. The internet website for voting by internet;
3. The suggested voting station should you wish to vote by composite paper ballot;
4. Your personalized and confidential Personal Identification Number (PIN);
5. A list of the candidates nominated for eligible offices; and
6. The telephone number for the Help Centre should you have any questions or need additional assistance.

You should receive your Voter Letter during the week of October 6, 2010.
