NOTICE OF NOMINATIONS FOR OFFICES**



TAKE notice that Nomination Forms may be filed in person or by agent at the Clerk's office, Township of South Stormont, 4949 County Road 14, Ingleside, ON K0C 1M0, during regular office hours, Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. excluding statutory holidays commencing on Monday, January 4, 2010 and ending on **Nomination Day, Friday, September 10, 2010 at 2:00 p.m.** for the following offices:

Mayor	One (1) to be elected at large
Deputy Mayor	One (1) to be elected at large
Councillors	Three (3) to be elected at large

**AND TAKE NOTICE** that Nominations for the office of School Trustee shall be filed with the designated Clerk's Office to be determined for:

- Upper Canada District School Board (English Public)
- Catholic District School Board of Eastern Ontario (English Separate)
- Conseil scolaire de district catholiques de l'Est ontarien (French Separate)
- Conseil des écoles publiques de l'Est de Ontario (French Public)

**AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE** that Nominations for all Offices shall be made in writing on the prescribed form available from the Clerk's Office of the appropriate municipality (please refer to the applicable municipal information box) or on the appropriate Township website and shall be accompanied by the prescribed nomination filing fee of \$200 for the office of Mayor and \$100 for all other offices. *The nomination filing fee shall be paid in cash or by certified cheque or money order made payable to the municipality.* The Nomination Form must be signed by the candidate and may be filed in person or by an agent, MEA, Section 33.

**Nominations for all offices shall close at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, September 10, 2010.** Nominations will only be certified when the Clerk is satisfied that the person is qualified to be nominated and that the nomination complies with the Act.

Candidates for municipal office must, upon nomination, be a qualified municipal elector and fulfill all of the following requirements:

- A resident of the municipality, a non-resident owner or tenant of land in the municipality or the spouse of such non-resident owner or tenant;
- A Canadian citizen;
- At least 18 years old;
- Not legally prohibited from voting; and
- Not disqualified by any legislation from holding municipal office.

**NOTE:** A candidate, if nominated, must remain qualified throughout the election and, if elected, throughout the term of office.

**AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE** that where, at 4:00 pm on Monday, September 13, 2010, the number of certified candidates is the same as the number to be elected, the clerk will declare the candidates elected by acclamation. Where the number of certified candidates is fewer than the number of positions to be elected, the clerk shall declare those candidates elected and call for additional nominations, which may be filed between 9:00 am and 2:00 pm on Wednesday, September 15, 2010.
