## WASTE MANAGEMENT REMINDERS

### What to do with Black and Blue?

#### Inside your BLUE Box

- Place loose (no bags please)
- Glass Bottles and Jars
- Aluminum and Steel Cans and Rigid
- Aluminum Foil Containers
- Metal Aerosol Cans
- Paint Cans and Lids (completely dried) and remove lids
- Plastic Bottles and Tubs



#### Inside your BLACK Box

- Boxboard (cereal, cookie, tissue, detergent, etc.)
- Soft Cover Books (no hard cover books)
- Household Paper
- Newspapers, inserts, magazines, catalogues and phone books

#### Beside your BLACK BOX

- Corrugated Cardboard – Flatten and bind in bundles not more than 36"X36"X12" thick. Keep corrugated cardboard and boxboard separate from newspapers

✓ Please ensure that your BLACK BOX material is in the BLACK BOX and your BLUE BOX material is in your BLUE BOX. If the containers are mixed, they will not be collected.

✓ Please make certain your garbage and recycling is placed at the curb by 7:00 AM ~ the routes are long and a 7:00 AM start is necessary.

## 10 TIPS TO SAVE WATER

1. Shorten your shower time
2. Go low-flow
3. Don't flush it away
4. Use a rain barrel
5. Let your lawn water itself
6. Shut off the hose
7. Fix leaky faucets
8. Fill the dishwasher first
